

Would you believe more Jewel Box units? But we're making real progress.

You will need Fabrics A, B2 and D this week.



From Fabric B2 cut 8 squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

From Fabric D cut 8 squares $2\frac{7}{8}$ ", crosscut once to give 16 triangles

From Fabric A cut 4 squares $4\frac{7}{8}$ ", crosscut once to give 8 triangles



By now you will know what to do and how to do it –
Join the B2 squares and D triangles into units as before, press and trim
RS together pair and join the newly-pieced units with the A triangles



Press and trim everything and label Unit 3, then remove to a safe place.
